get





Inclusive schools can help students with disability do well at school.




To help schools be inclusive

 teachers should know how to support students with disability



 students should be able to tell schools about problems and get them fixed




 the government should write a plan that tells schools how to be inclusive.

## Schools should stop segregation







Segregation is when schools keep students with disability away from other students.



To help **stop** segregation

 schools should learn why segregation does not help students with disability



 students with disability could help plan new ways to teach students all together



 schools should have classes that are for all students.



In time there should be no more special schools for students with disability.




# Schools should help students with disability finish school

We want more students with disability to finish year 12 at school.



Students who finish year 12 can

• get a job





- go to **TAFE** 
  - TAFE is a place students can learn new skills after high school



• do job training.



To help more students with disability finish year 12

 schools should plan learning that is right for each student



 teachers should know how to make classes more inclusive



- students need the right supports for their disability
  - for example, help with communication



 students with disability should learn the same things all students learn.

## Schools should be fairer



Students with disability have the right to go to the school they want.

It is **disability discrimination** if a school does **not** let a student in because of their disability.



To help make schools fairer

 we should help students and families know about disability discrimination



 schools should have to say why they did not take a student



schools should have a mix of students



• we should say well done to inclusive schools.

# Schools should stop using restrictive practices

We think **restrictive practices** stop students with disability getting their rights to education.



Restrictive practices mean things like

• a strap to stop someone moving



holding someone to stop them moving





locking a room to stop someone getting out



medicine to make someone calm.



We want schools to **stop** restrictive practices.



To help stop restrictive practices

 teachers should be trained in better ways to work with students with disability



 an outside person should check on restrictive practices at the school



 schools should help students with disability tell them if there is a problem



 schools should know why restrictive practices are not safe



 schools should follow rules about restrictive practices.

## We should keep students going to school

Many students with disability get

- suspended
- expelled.



Suspended is when the school stops you going to school for a short time.



Expelled is when the school asks you to leave the school forever.



To help students with disability keep going to school we should talk about better ways to support them.



### We think schools should

• talk about problems with students and families



 tell people how many students they suspend or expel



only suspend or expel students if there is
 no other choice.

## What will help change education?



To help make education better for students with disability we should

• listen to students with disability






• change disability rules and laws



make a plan about inclusive education



check that schools follow the plan



 help schools get money to support students with disability.



To help make education better for students with disability we should also

 show teachers the best ways to teach students with disability



• have more teachers with disability.




We should also support students and families.
