
About this book

Foundational supports



The survey is about **foundational supports**.



Foundational supports are for disabled people.



There will be 2 types of foundational supports.

The 2 types of foundational supports will be general foundational supports and targeted foundational supports.

General foundational supports are for



disabled people



• family and carers of disabled people



People who are on the NDIS can use general supports.




Targeted foundational supports are for disabled people who are not on the NDIS.

Targeted supports are for people who need help with different things.



For example, targeted supports can be for people with **developmental delay**.



Developmental delay is when it is hard for a child to do things that other children can do.



For example, a child might need help to walk.



The government wants to hear from you about general supports.



The government will start to ask about targeted supports in October.



You will have a few months to tell the government what you think about targeted supports.

This survey is about general supports.

• are a person with disability



• are a parent or carer of a person with disability



• work for a disability organisation.


You can also say you

• do research at a university.




You can choose more than 1 answer.

4. We will ask about your **gender**.

Your gender might be



woman



man



• something else.



You do not have to tell us your gender.

5. We will ask if you are



Aboriginal



• Torres Strait Islander



We will also ask if you are from a different culture.



We will also ask if you are LGBTQIA



You can say you do not want to answer.



6. We will ask for your postcode.

Questions about foundational supports




7. We will ask if you understand foundational supports.



8. We will ask what you want to know about foundational supports.




9. We will ask how you want us to tell you about foundational supports.

We will ask you to tell us why you feel how you do about foundational supports.




12. We will ask what you want foundational supports to be.
