




CYDA means Children and Young People with Disability Australia.




We support young people with disability who are

We will tell you what hard words mean.




You can ask someone to help you read this book.

life changes.

Resources might be



videos



blog posts



• something else.

What you will do

If you are part of the project, you will go to meetings.



The meetings will be online, on Zoom.



We will have 6 meetings.



The meetings will go for 2 hours.

How we will pay people

We will pay people who come to project meetings.



We will pay 100 dollars for every meeting.

You can choose to be paid



• into a bank account



• with a voucher.

Consent to the government



We have to share some information about the people in the project.



We have to share some information with the government.



We can make information we share with the government **anonymous**.



Anonymous means the government will not know who the information is about.



The government will keep the information we share in Australia.



You can contact the government Department of Social Services for more information.


If you consent we will tell the government



• your first name and last name



• the day you were born



• your gender.

We will also share



• your address



• if you are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander



• what country you were born in



• the language you speak at home



• your disability.




The form will ask if you say we can share your information with the government.

We will ask if you want to be part of a group for



• young people with disability



• parents or carers.



This book is for young people with disability who are

13 to 17 years old.

The form will ask if your parent or carer will let you





• fill in the form


• be part of the project.



We will ask the name of your parent or carer.



We will ask for the phone number of your parent or carer.



We will ask for your first name and last name.

We will ask for your **pronouns**.



Pronouns are words you want us to use when we talk about you.

We will ask for



• your date of birth



• the state you live in.



We will ask for your home address



We will ask for your email address.



We will also ask for your phone number.



We will ask how you want us to contact you.


You can say



• email



• phone call



• text message.



You can also say you want a zoom call.

We will ask if you have disability.



You do not need a **diagnosis** to be part of the project.



Diagnosis means a doctor says you have disability.



The form will ask what disability you have.



You do not have to tell us what disability you have.

Access needs



Access needs are things that can support you to be part of meetings.



The form will ask about your access needs.



We want to know about your access needs to help you be part of the project.



You do not have to tell us your access needs.

Access needs might be



• Auslan or sign language



• breaks



• captions



• Easy Read.

Your access needs might also be



• information in a language not English



• support worker.




You can tell us if you have an access need that is not on our list.

Your gender might be




• woman

We will ask if you are from a different culture or religion.




We will ask if you live in a **regional, rural or remote area**.

We will also ask if you are a parent or carer.

We will ask if you want to be a CYDA member.



You can say yes or no.


