
About this book

For example, disabled young people might speak a language that is not English.




We will make sure people know that disabled young people can be in **poverty**.

For example, we might share information about **inclusive education**.




Inclusive education means that disabled children and non disabled children can learn together.

We will help **codesign** support for children with disability.



Codesign means we work with disabled people and family and carers on projects about disability.

We will do **systemic advocacy** to make sure children with disability get support.



Systemic advocacy means we try to help all children with disability.

For example




 we want to make sure every student can go to a school near where they live


